On behalf of the Management, the staff and the students, I welcome you all to this magnificent edifice of learning on its Diamond Jubilee Year 1956-2016, the 60th year, founded by the great philanthropist Hajee Karutha Rowther, with a vision of promoting higher education for the uplift of the poor and the downtrodden in and around the Cumbum Valley. We have been sailing in the sea of his noble mission in producing talented young men and women to serve the society every year.

With pride and immense pleasure, I present the annual report for this Academic Year 2015 – 2016 which has witnessed many successful events and a record of number of activities.

Strength And Courses

In the last two decades, we have made considerable progress in terms of infrastructures, updating courses and strength of students. This year we have a strength of 2321 students of which 1443 are women.

In the Government Aided- Scheme, our college offers Under Graduate Courses in Economics, English, History, Commerce, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, and Computer Science. At the Post Graduate level, we have History and Commerce. Under the Self – Finance Scheme, we have B.B.A, B.Com (Banking) B.Com with Computer Application, B.Sc. Bio – Chemistry, Micro – Biology, Information Technology. At P.G. level M.A. Economics, M.A. English, M.Com. (CA), M.Sc. Mathematics, M.Sc. (C.S & I.T), M.Sc. Chemistry and at Research level M.Phil. Commerce, M.Phil. History, M.Phil. Mathematics and M.Phil. Chemistry. The Department of Commerce is also a recognized Research centre of Madurai Kamaraj University, where the aspirants can register for Ph.D. as there are recognized guides of various Universities.

The Anti – Dowry Club of our College was launched by our Secretary and Correspondent on 21st December, 2015, with the object of creating awareness among students on the evils of dowry.

Our College is a study centre for IGNOU which offers certificate courses in Spoken English, Commerce, Economics, etc.

Mr. R. Mohamed Rafeek, Assistant Professor of Tamil, Organized “*n`sjpah ,yf;fpaRw;wk;*” It was inaugurated on 8th October, 2015 in our college premises in order to motivate the students’ creative skills.

Our college has installed 10 CCTV Cameras in and around the college buildings and campus as a safety measure of the college, staff and students.

Our college, which has been recognized by the Madurai Kamaraj University, as a Community college centre, has been training more than 100 Volunteers in Mushroom Cultivation. At present Mr. Parthiban, Assistant Professor of Micro – Biology, is the Co-ordinator.

The Indoor Stadium, with a capacity of more than two thousand audience where we are all seated, has been built under UGC Grant of Rupees Seventy Lakhs which has amounted to Rupees One Crore and Twenty Lakhs and that amount has exceeded to for its completion, of which Rupees Fifty Lakhs has been contributed by our College Management.

The College Management is magnanimous enough to purchase more than one thousand moulded chairs, for the use of audience in the indoor stadium, also to library and computer labs, from its own fund.
