Let me extend a Warm Welcome and express my hearty College Day Greetings to all of you.

Welcome to this magnificent edifice of learning on its 62nd anniversary, founded by the great philanthropist Hajee Karutha Rowther with a vision of promoting higher education for the upliftment of the poor and the downtrodden in and around Cumbum Valley. We have been sailing in the sea of his noble mission in producing talented young men and women to serve the society every year.

With pride and immense pleasure, I present in brief, the annual report for this academic year 2017 – 2018 which witnessed many successful events and a record of a number of activities.

Strength and Courses

The tremendous development of our college is measured by the growing strength of the students and the number of courses offered every year. This year our college boosts of an over-whelming students' strength of 2364 of which 1428 are women. The college offers Under Graduate Courses in Economics, English, History, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Computer Science and Commerce. At the Post Graduate level, we have History, and Commerce. Under the Self – Finance Scheme, we have B.A. Arabic, Business Administration, Banking Management, B.Com. with Computer Application, B.Sc. Bio – Chemistry, B.Sc.Micro – Biology, B.Sc Information Technology, M.Sc. Mathematics, M.Sc. C.S, M.Sc. Physics, M.Sc. Chemistry, M.Sc. Zoology, M.A. Economics, M.A. English, M.A., Tamil, M.Com. (CA), M.Phil. Commerce, M.Phil English, M.Phil Chemistry, M.Phil.Mathematics and M.Phil History. The Department of Commerce is also a recognized centre for Research Activities. We have submitted the proposal to Madurai Kamaraj University to start B.A. Tamil from the next Academic Year. Non-Affiliated courses have been started from this Academic Year by all the 18 departments of our institution.

With a view to inculcate Islamic principles in the young minds of the Muslim students, Deeniyath classes are conducted every Wednesday after the college hours, and regular examination is conducted at the end of the academic year for the **I** and **II** year Muslim students. As many as twenty prizes are distributed to them based on their performance.

Our College is a study centre for IGNOU which offers Certificate, Diploma and Degree courses in Spoken English, Commerce, Economics and various subjects.

Our college, which has been recognized by the Madurai Kamaraj University as a Community college centre is training more than 100 Volunteers in Mushroom Cultivation. At present. Mr. P. Sivamanikandan Assistant Professor of Micro – Biology, is acting as Co–ordinator.

One more bus was purchased this year to cater to the growing strength of women students' safe conveyance to the college. Altogether 10 buses are operated for the women students.

The UGC has released an Autonomous Grant of Rs. 16,00,000 towards financial assistance for autonomous colleges.

In response to the UGC directive that made NAAC Re-accreditation for all the institutions of higher education mandatory, NAAC Committee and IQAC Cell was reconstituted in June 2017 with Mr.S.Sirajudeen, Head & Associate Professor, Department of Computer Science, as Co-ordinator of IQAC as well as Dr.M.Basheer Ahamed Meeran, Associate Professor, Department of History, as Co-ordinator of NAAC Steering and Autonomous Committee.Mr. S.Peer Mohaideen Mudalali, Associate Professor, Department of

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Computer Science, is the Assistant Co-ordinator of both the above mentioned NAAC Committee and IQAC Cell. Quality Circles were constituted and quality policies were framed. The faculty of the institution contributed in the implementation of quality policies and worked very hard to ensure timely submission of documents and forms.

A number of departmental societies and extra-curricular activity societies were constituted and each society conducted various programmes in each semester. The initial formalities were approved by NAAC and the Self Study Report (SSR) was proposed to be submitted by the college. The report was compiled, edited and proof –read, and is likely to be uploaded on the college website.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has been set up as per UGC guidelines to implement the quality policy of the college and to bring about continuous improvement in teaching- learning processes and other related administrative mechanisms. In association with IQAC, the departments have organized various programmes like National and International Seminars, Workshops, Awareness Programmes, etc. Yoga, Meditation Course, Women's Forum, and certain other activities have also been started for the welfare of men and women students in our college. The annual re-union of the alumni Association was held in Feb 2018. In accordance with the government directive, the IQAC Cell has also proposed to set up an Electoral Literacy Club in our institution.

The management has appointed the following 34 Teaching and 2 Non –Teaching staff in the existing vacancies under the Aided and Self - Finance section, so that the class work and the administrative work are in no way affected.
