By the Grace of the Almighty, Our College is making a steady growth realizing the dream of our founder. With much pleasure and pride, let me now present the Annual Report for the Academic year 2018-2019.

Strength and Courses

In the last two decades, we have made considerable progress in terms of infrastructure, introduction of courses and strength of students. This year we have strength of **2527** students of which **1,485** are women.

We offer Under Graduate courses in Economics, English, History, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Computer Science and Commerce. At the Post Graduate level, we have History and Commerce. Under the Self –Finance Scheme, we have B.A. Arabic, B.A. Tamil, B.B.A., B.Com. (Banking), and B.Com. with Computer Application, B.Sc. Bio-Chemistry, B.Sc. Micro – Biology, B.Sc. Information Technology, M.Sc. Mathematics, M.Sc. Computer Science,

M.Sc. Physics, M.Sc. Chemistry, M.Sc. Zoology, M.A. Economics, M.A. English, M.A. Tamil, M.Com.(CA), M.Phil. Commerce, M.Phil. English, M.Phil. Chemistry, M.Phil. Mathematics and M.Phil. History. The Department of Commerce is also a recognized centre for Research Activities. Non-Affiliated courses have also been started from this academic year by all the 18 departments of our institution.

Deeniyath classes are conducted every Wednesday after the college hours to the Muslim students with a view to inculcate Islamic principles in the young minds. Our college is a study centre of IGNOU which offers diploma courses in Spoken English , Commerce, Economics and various subjects.

Our College which has been recognized by the Madurai Kamaraj University as a Community College Centre is training nearly 100 volunteers in Mushroom Cultivation. At present, Mr. P. Siva Manikandan, Assistant Professor of Micro- Biology, is its Co-ordinator.

One more bus has been purchased this year to cater to the growing strength of women students' safe conveyance to the college. Altogether, **10** buses are operated for the women students.

The UGC has released an Autonomous Grant of Rs. 16,00,000 towards financial assistance for autonomous colleges.

In association with IQAC, the departments of our institution have organized various programmes like National and International Seminars, Workshops, Awareness Programmes, etc.

All the classrooms and seminar halls are equipped with 82 LED Projectors to promote ICT enabled Teaching, which has the potential to transform the nature and process of teaching and learning environment.

Our campus is going Green, Eco- Friendly and Plastic Free, and a digital display board has been installed in the college premises, which also finds way for effective communication with students, staff and employees about the ongoing events in the college.

E-Service – a student self service portal is instituted in the college campus for the students to avail Public Internet Service Domain.
