Strength and Courses

In the last two decades, we have made considerable progress in terms of infrastructure, introduction of courses and strength of students. This year we have strength of 2,727 students of which 1,517 are women.

We offer Under Graduate Programmes in Economics, English, History, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Computer Science and Commerce under the Aided Scheme. At the Post Graduate level, we have History and Commerce. Under the Self - Finance Scheme, we have B.A. Arabic, B.A. Tamil, B.B.A., Commerce (Banking), Commerce with Computer Application, B.Sc. Biochemistry, B.Sc. Microbiology, B.Sc. Information Technology, M.Sc. Mathematics, M.Sc. Computer Science, M.Sc. Physics, M.Sc. Chemistry, M.Sc. Zoology, M.A. Economics, M.A. English, M.A. Tamil, M.Com. with Computer Application, M.Phil. Commerce, M.Phil. English, M.Phil. Chemistry, M.Phil. Mathematics and M.Phil. History. The Department of Commerce, Physics, English are also recognized Centres for Research.

Deeniyath classes are conducted every Wednesday after the college hours to the Muslim students with a view to inculcate Islamic principles in the young minds. Our college is a study centre of IGNOU which offers diploma courses in Spoken English, Commerce, Economics and various subjects.

Our College, recognized by the Madurai Kamaraj University as a Community College Centre, is training nearly 100 volunteers in Mushroom Cultivation.

In association with IQAC, the departments of our institution have organized various online programmes like National and International Webinars, Workshops, Awareness Programmes, E-Quiz and the like.
