I am glad to present the account of events that enlivened the 66<sup>th</sup> academic year of our reputed institution. Our college has maintained a trajectory of steady and sustained growth realizing the dream of the Founder, Hajee Karutha Rowther since its inception in 1956. The growth of the college has been stupendous in terms of its infrastructure, departments and new courses and throws light on the path of the educational needs of the poor section of the society. It is a matter of great pride and honour that the institution was accorded with the highest Grade A<sup>++</sup>, which is awarded only to a few best-in-class institutions for higher learning, by NAAC on 05th, April 2022.

At this juncture, Our gratitude is due to the Coordinator of NAAC Steering Committee Dr. M. Basheer Ahamed Meeran, Associate Professor of History, Coordinator of Internal Quality Assurance Cell Mr. S. Sirajudeen, Associate Professor & Head, Computer Science, Assistant Coordinator of NAAC Steering Committee and IQAC Mr. S. Peer Mohaideen Mudalali, Associate Professor of Computer Science. I wish to appreciate the efforts and support rendered by the Management, the Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff and the Students.

In the last two decades, we have made considerable progress in terms of introduction of courses and strength of students. This year we have a strength of 2,623 students of which 1422 are women.

In the Aided stream, our College offers Under Graduate courses in Economics, English, History, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Computer Science and Commerce. At the Post Graduate level, we have History and Commerce programmes. Under the Self–Finance Scheme, we have Undergraduate programmes in Arabic, Tamil, Business Administration, Commerce (Banking), Commerce with (CA), Bio-Chemistry, Microbiology, Information Technology, Postgraduate programmes in Mathematics, Computer Science, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Economics, English, Tamil, Commerce with (CA) and M.Phil programmes in Commerce, English, Chemistry, Mathematics and History. The Departments of Commerce, Physics and English are recognized Research Centres of Madurai Kamaraj University. Non-Affiliated courses have also been started from this academic year by all the 18 departments of our institution.

Our College is a study centre of IGNOU which offers Certificate courses in Beekeeping, Tourism Studies, Environmental Studies, Arabic Language, etc.

Our College organised the District Level Tamil and English Oratorical Competitions conducted by the State Miniroties Commission, Tamil Nadu on 14<sup>th</sup>, March 2022 in our College. More than 24 Colleges participated in the event.

The Alumni Association of our institution organised a Workshop in commemoration of World Students' Day. Moreover a seminar entitled "Employment Opportunities Abroad" was also organised with our alumnus Mr. Mohamed Ashik, Production Manager, ADWAN Chemical Limited, Riyath, Saudi Arabia as the resource person.

A Four Day Student Induction and Orientation Programme "Deeksharambh" with the motto "Breaking the Barriers" was conducted for the first-year undergraduates through the online mode from 6<sup>th</sup> September to 8<sup>th</sup> September 2021 as well as 12<sup>th</sup>, October 2021. More than Seven hundred freshers from seventeen departments were the beneficiaries of the Student Induction programme.

Our College which has been recognized as a Community College Centre by the Madurai Kamaraj University is training nearly 100 volunteers in Mushroom Cultivation.

Altogether, 12 buses are operated for the women students' safe conveyance to the college.

In association with IQAC, the Departments of our institution have organized various online programmes like National and International Webinars, Workshops, Awareness Programmes, etc.

All the classrooms and seminar halls are equipped with 82 LED Projectors to promote ICT enabled Teaching, which has the potential to transform the nature and process of teaching and learning environment.

Our College has Go-Green, Eco- Friendly and Plastic Free campus. A digital display board has been installed in the college premises, which also finds way for effective communication with students and staff about the ongoing events in the college.

E-Service, a student self-service portal is instituted in the college campus for the students to avail Public Internet Service Domain.
