Being the Head of the Institution, I wish to greet you all on this auspicious occasion of our College day celebrations being held today.

On behalf of the Management, the Staff, and the Students, I welcome you all to this magnificent edifice of learning on its 69<sup>th</sup> College Day Celebrations, founded by the great philanthropist Hajee Karutha Rowther, with a vision of promoting higher education for the upliftment of the poor and the downtrodden in and around Cumbum Valley. We have been sailing in the sea of his noble mission in producing talented young men and women to serve the society year after year. This Academic Year 2024 - 2025 is marked with events and stories of success. Our Institution has been placed within the **201 - 300 Rank Band** in the **NIRF India Rankings 2024** by the Ministry of Education, India. With pride and immense pleasure, I present the Annual Report of this Academic Year 2024 - 2025.

### **Strength and Courses**

In the last two decades, we have made considerable progress in terms of infrastructure, updating courses and strength of students. This year we have strength of 2510 students including 1418 women.

In the Aided Stream, our College offers Undergraduate Programmes in Economics, English, History, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Computer Science and Commerce. At the Postgraduate level, we have History and Commerce Programmes. Under the Self - Finance Scheme, in addition to the Undergraduate Programmes in Arabic, Tamil, Business Administration, Commerce (Banking), Commerce with Computer Application, Biochemistry, Microbiology, and Information Technology, we have Postgraduate Programmes in Mathematics, Computer Science, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Economics, English, Tamil, and Commerce with Computer Application, as well as M.Phil. Programmes in Commerce, English, Chemistry, Mathematics and History. The Departments of Commerce, Physics, English, History and Zoology are recognized Research Centres of Madurai Kamaraj University. Non - affiliated Value - Added Courses have been conducted by the Departments of Business Administration, Commerce with Computer Application, Microbiology and Information Technology in this academic year.

At this juncture, I wish to express my gratitude to our College Management for their generous donation of **Rs. 8,00,000/-** towards the development of our College. Besides the new Auditorium erected with a seating capacity of 2500 people on Campus, a new Restroom for men students has also been constructed behind the PG Block. The College is an IGNOU Study Centre that provides Certificate Programmes in subjects like Arabic Language, Tourism Studies, Environmental Studies and Beekeeping. Altogether 12 college buses are operated for the safe conveyance of women students.

Green Energy and Environmental Audits were conducted on 18<sup>th</sup> June 2024. Our College was conferred with the **Award of Best College for Blood Donation** on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2024. A **Rally against Discrimination** was conducted in the presence of our District Collector Mr. Ranjeet Singh, IAS, and the District Superintendent of Police Mr. R. Shiva Prasad, IPS, on 6<sup>th</sup> March 2025. Further, our Institution was presented a **Memorial Shield** as a token of appreciation by the Department of Police, Theni District. On 19<sup>th</sup> March 2025, Mr. Ranjeet Singh, IAS, District Collector, presided over the **Antidrug Awareness Programme** conducted on our College campus, following which a student **Rally** was also organized. Around **24 Functional MoUs** have been signed with different Institutions, Professional Bodies and NGOs for the sustenance of quality education, promotion of research and to foster industry - academia collaboration. Meanwhile Mr. Ahamed Mottaki, CEO of MIANZ International College, Maldives, visited our Institution and has signed an **MoU** with our College on 13<sup>th</sup> December 2024.

The **NAAC Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR)** for the year 2023 - 2024 was submitted successfully by the IQAC on 24<sup>th</sup> December 2024. Similarly, the **AISHE** data and **NIRF** data were also submitted on 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2024 and 10<sup>th</sup> January 2025 respectively. The Departments of our College have organized a number of events in collaboration with IQAC, including **Workshops** such as “**Cultural Heritage of Tamils with reference to Keeladi Excavations**”, “**A Journey towards Afforestation**” and “**Soft Skill Development**”. The Alumni Association of our College organized the **Alumni Meet** on 21<sup>st</sup> September 2024 as well as 04<sup>th</sup> January 2025, which was attended by more than 1500 alumni.

A **Five-day Student Induction and Orientation Programme – “Deeksharambh”** was conducted for the First Year Undergraduates from 24<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> June 2024. Around 692 Freshers from seventeen Departments were the beneficiaries of the Student Induction Programme.

The 82 LED projectors installed in Classrooms and Seminar Halls support ICT-enabled teaching, which has the power to change the structure and methodology of the teaching and learning process completely.

In keeping with our Institution’s green, eco-friendly, and plastic-free policy, a Digital Display Board has been put in place on campus to facilitate effective communication with staff, students, and employees about the ongoing events of our College.

E-Service, a student self-service portal, is functioning on the College campus for the students to avail Public Internet Service Domain.
