#### Quality initiatives of IQAC

- The IQAC monitors the academic activities to ensure the standard in Teaching, Learning, Evaluation, Research and Extension activities.
- Counseling Psychologist was appointed by the management for the benefit of students
- IQAC conducted an Orientation Programme on "Data Analysis and Communication" on 4.8.2016
- IQAC Organized a Seminar on Teaching and Learning Through ICT on 3.9.2016
- IQAC Organized an Awareness Programmes on Road Safety on 03.1.2017
- IQAC & Department of Commerce Organized a Conference on "Digital India Challenges Ahead" on 1.3.2017

## Status of Curriculum Design and Development

- The Syllabi introduced under Autonomous pattern with modifications, additions and deletions if any, approved by the Academic Council are followed.
- Core, Electives, Non-Major Electives, Skill Based Subjects, Value Education and Environmental Studies have been included in the syllabi at the UG level.
- B.A., Arabic, M.A., Tamil and M.Phil. English programmes were started.

#### Status of Teaching and learning

- The performance in Teaching and Learning is periodically discussed, reviewed by the Members of the Management Committee, Principal and IQAC of the College.
- The students were engaged in seminar classes with e-content.
- The College provided latest technologies and facilities for the benefit of the faculty members in order to enhance their effectiveness in teaching-learning process.
- The college has provided LCD projectors to all the Science Departments, to facilitate the staff to shift to ICT enabled teaching.
- The students are given opportunity to make use of Internet connectivity for e-learning.
- The staff were encouraged to take the classes with the tools of ICT.

#### Status of Research and Innovations

- Two faculties were awarded Ph.D.
- Two faculties submitted Ph.D., theses and two faculties registered for Ph.D.
- Three faculties were awarded M.Phil degrees.
- Two faculty members applied for Minor Research Projects.
- 54 Research Articles were published by the faculty members.
- Twenty Six faculty members presented Research Papers at various Seminars and Conferences.
- Sixty Four faculty members attended various Seminars and Conferences.
- Ten faculty members acted as Resource Persons and delivered 26 Guest Lectures.
- Fourteen faculty members were served as members of Board of Studies.

#### Status of Infrastructure of the college

- Community college for school dropouts and destitute was created.
- Fire Safety Kit was installed in appropriate places in every building.
- ICT tools were used for efficient class room teaching.
- E-Journals were subscribed through DELNET.
- More college buses were purchased for women students.
- Separate resting place for women students was constructed with good amenities.
- Free Browsing Centre was arranged for the benefit of students.

## Status of Students' support and progression

- The total number of beneficiaries of Baithulmal in the year 2016-17 is 9. Total amount given to the beneficiaries Rs. 22,500
- The total number of beneficiaries of Students Welfare Fund (Students Aid Fund) in the year 2017-18 is 1.
   Total amount given to the beneficiaries Rs. 1,500/-.
- The institution provides free coaching for Government and Non-Government or Banking services through Centre for Entry in Services.
- The College has a Career Guidance and Counseling Centre for the benefit of the students. The Centre disseminates information on job opportunities and conducts coaching classes and training programmes pertaining to placement.
- Under the Student Connect Programme sponsored by Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India,
   Career Guidance Cell of the College made arrangements for getting Passport to 120 students.

Based on the suggestions of the IQAC, the College Management created the Student Support benefits like
well furnished Women's hostel, separate resting place for women students with amenities, fine Arts Club to
identify individual talents of the students, awards for the Best Library Users and scribers for helping the
disabled students both inside and outside the campus.

#### **Status of Library**

- Library performances were connected with the Flair software.
- The Open Access system for borrowing books was implemented successfully for the benefit of the students.
- Book exhibition was organized for four days from 7<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> February, 2017 in which books on a variety of subjects were displayed.
- The Reading Club was `initiated by the Library to improve the reading habit of the students
- E-Journals are subscribed through DELNET
- 2922 text books and 22 reference books are recently added to the existing numbers.
- 6 new journals were added newly to the existing numbers of journals.
- In addition to general library every Department has a separate library.

#### **Activities of Career Guidance Cell**

- National Digital Literacy Mission (NDLM) Examination was conducted on 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> April, 2016 in which 78 final year undergraduates participated. The participants received the Appreciation of Digital Literacy Certificate issued by the Central Government.
- In the On-Campus recruitment conducted by Alcance Tech, Chennai on 17<sup>th</sup> February 2017, five students was selected.
- In association with Techno Chase Info Solutions, Theni, the Career Guidance Cell arranged an on-line business training "Digital Financial Mission", on 20th February, 2017.

- A One-day Motivation Programme was organized in association with Adone Publications for TNPSC Group Services Examinations on 22nd October 2016 on "How to Clear TNPSC Exam".
